PERFORMERS REQUIREMENTS

Please complete form indicating any special equipment needs or set up requirements. Performers are expected to arrive in time for set up and short sound test prior to performance. We recommend 45 minutes to 1 hour prior to performance.

PAYMENT FOR PERFORMANCE

Duvall Foundation for the Arts will pay a small amount to each band. DFA raises money through sponsorship from businesses and community members. In order to keep the event FREE to the public we work with a very small budget.

SET UP – Load In/Out

Load in: From the McCormick Park entrance, drive over the curb, keeping to the right of the bathroom. Follow the driveway to the chain link gate and pass through. Turn left onto the walking trail, and travel to the South Entrance of McCormick Park.

There will be volunteers in the festival area on Saturday night keeping watch over the performance equipment and stage. **All equipment and booths left overnight are, however, left at the participant's own risk.**
